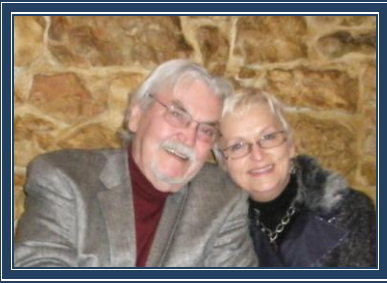

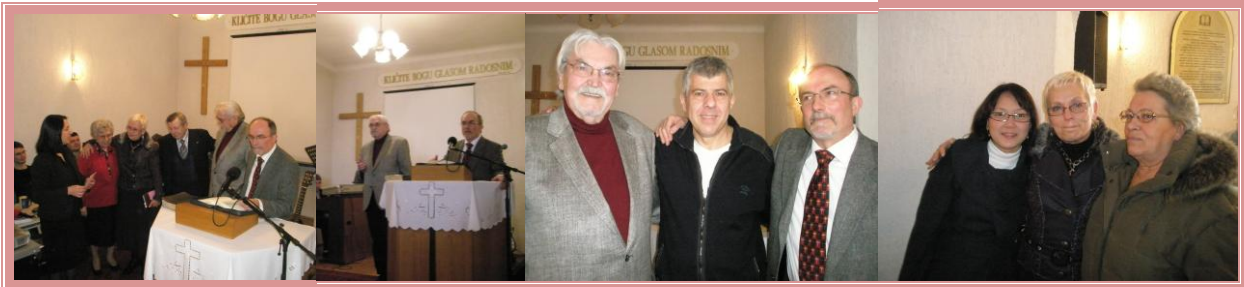


Muffi & Mushka make sure we don't forget them.
